Call to Order

Communication from the Public

There was no public communication.

Presentation

Ms. Eisinger, Director of Curriculum, State-Federal Funding, presented an overview and answered Board Member questions regarding curriculum. Discussion included the following:

- District Improvement Process (DIP)
 - The DIP is a continuous improvement cycle; assessing strengths and weaknesses with input from stakeholders. This cycle drives all efforts.
- District Leadership Team
 - Members of DLT include district administrators, individual building representatives (including principals, teachers, parents, and students), and community leaders.
 - DLT meets four times per year. The next two meetings are scheduled for March 10 and May 12, 2017, from 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
 - DLT would like to recommend that the district's vision statement be changed to: *Every Student, Every Day...Commit, Succeed, and Lead!*
- Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA)
 - NWEA is a growth model student assessment tool.
 - Per the State, data from the assessment is used for a percentage of teacher and administrator evaluations.
